KidSport is a national non-profit organization that gets kids off the sidelines and into the game by helping overcome the financial barriers that prevent some young people from participating in sport. Through an application process, local KidSport chapters provide grants to help with the cost of registration fees and/or equipment for sustained sport programs (e.g. a season of soccer, a session of gymnastics, swimming lessons, etc.) with qualified instructors for kids under the age of 18 years. Individual grants will vary by local chapter but typically range from \$200-\$300 per calendar year. By providing all kids an opportunity to participate in organized sport programs, we help encourage early physical activity habits that will help increase the probability that kids will remain active in adulthood. KidSport helps to create opportunities for sport participation and plays a significant role in supporting many low-income families in Alberta.
